ASBPA GLO 2007 Field Trips

Sunday, October 21, 2007

Galveston & Follets Island Beach Tour

Duration: 9am – 4:45 pm *Max. Attendance:* 50 *Cost per person:* \$50

Transportation: 1 bus equipped with audio and driver

Lunch: box lunch catered by Jason's Deli (or similar)

Snacks: Water/sodas/small munchies

This field trip will be an all-day guided tour of the Gulf shoreline of Galveston and Follets Island from the Galveston jetties to the Village of Surfside, with stops to view coastal erosion response projects and shoreline management challenges. The tour will feature a continuing technical discussion led by several coastal erosion experts with experience in the Galveston area. A box lunch and snacks will be included.

Galveston City History Tour

Duration: 1pm – 5pm *Max. Attendance:* 25 *Cost per person:* \$25

Transportation: 3 minivans (existing vans that GLO will have available)

Snacks: water/sodas/small munchies

This field trip will be a half-day, afternoon tour of the City of Galveston that will showcase the culture and history of the city. Attendees will make stops at two historic Victorian-era homes of the residential city and then proceed to a walking tour of the “Dickens era” ambience of the historic Strand Blvd in downtown. The field trip will culminate in a visit to the museum of The Great Storm that includes a cinematic production of the Galveston Hurricane of 1900.

Departure, dress and other details

Both trips will depart and return from the main entrance of the **Hilton Hotel**. Please be at the boarding location at least 15 min. prior to departure to get checked in and to order the box lunch if they are going on the beach tour. Transportation will be leaving promptly at the designated time for each to ensure that the itinerary is followed.

Beach tour: 9:00 am

City history tour: 1:00 pm

Dress is casual for both trips. Consider the weather in the field on the beach tour. Activity will include only light walking. Hats and sunscreen may be appropriate.
