

Amendment Number: [S.Amdt. 1090](#) to [S.Amdt. 1065](#) to [H.R. 1495](#) (Water Resources Development Act of 2007)

Statement of Purpose: To prioritize Federal spending to ensure the residents of the city of Sacramento are protected from the threat of floods before spending money to add sand to beaches in San Diego.

The Senate voted on May 15th to defeat a WRDA amendment offered by Senator Coburn of Oklahoma that would have delayed funding for the Imperial Beach Nourishment Project until the Sacramento River Flood Control Project (\$350 million) is fully funded. This is the first amendment offered by any Senator and its defeat shows strong support for the Water Resources development Act and for the federal shore protection project.
